Dhaka the Capital of Bangladesh:

Dhaka, also spelled as Dacca, is the capital city of the South Asian country, Bangladesh. It is the hub of economic, political, and administrative enterprises located in central Bangladesh at 23°42′N 90°22′E, on the eastern banks of the Buriganga River. It lies on the lower reaches of the Ganges Delta and covers a total area of 306.38 square kilometers (around 118.29 square miles). Historically, Dhaka's name is said to refer to the dhak tree, once common in the area, or to Dhakeshwari ("The Hidden Goddess"), whose shrine is located in the western part of the city. Dhaka is also known as the City of Mosques, as per Islamic Foundation, there are more than 6000 mosques in Dhaka City including Baitul Mukarram Mosque, which is known as the National Mosque of Bangladesh.

Dhaka was associated with the periods of the Kamarupa kingdom, Sena kingdom, and Sultanate period, and was a part of the Mughal Empire, Nawab era, the British and Pakistani colonialism. The capital has a favorable climate characterized by tropical monsoon from June to October; mild winter from October to March; hot, humid summer from March to June. The demographic features of the city are varied in character. Dhaka (North and South) city corporations are the most populated urban areas with the highest density accommodating over 21 million people including Muslims, Hindus, Christians, Buddhists, and others.

Dhaka is rich with its long historical and archaeological heritage. It is considered one of the oldest cities in the globe comprising ancient monuments including Ahsan Manzil, Lalbagh Fort, Bahadur Shah Park, Bara Katra, Armenian Church, The Dhaka Gate, Rose Garden Palace, Ruplal House, and the modern excellence of the National Parliament Building. The Bangla Academy, situated inside the Dhaka University campus, organizes a month-long Amar Ekushey Boi Mela (Book Fair) every year to commemorate the Bangla Language Movement where global communities celebrate it as International Mother Language Day.

Dhaka is famous for its Rickshaw ride worldwide. Rickshaw transportation is one of the pollution-free transport systems in the world which is available in Dhaka. Both private and public vehicles, including Uber, Pathao, and Obhai CNG systems are popular. Commonly known shopping areas, supermarkets like Basundhara Shopping Mall and Jamuna Future Park fulfill the demand of the customers. Aarong, a subsidiary brand of BRAC, is famous for its local clothing products with authentic Bengali identity. For entertainment, Star Cineplex and Blockbuster Cinemas, Balaka, Modhumita, and Shamoly cinema halls are popular among the young generations for enjoying local and international movies. Dhaka is also prominent for its stage dramas. The Shilpakala Academy, Mahila Samiti Mancha, and the University of Dhaka are the most popular places for celebrating cultural programs on national days.

EMPOWERING LOCAL TOURISM COMMUNITY AFTER THE PANDEMIC: FACULTY-SOCIETY JOINT RESEARCH INITIATIVE IN BINTAN, INDONESIA

Abstract

There have been significant efforts from academics and local communities in strengthening the ties among them by collaborating in different fields, especially after the pandemic. Community-related research initiatives between universities and society are common as a way to help each other in enhancing social and economic recovery after being hit by COVID-19 for more than two years (2020-2021). In Indonesia, communities actively participate in research provided by faculty members. With Airlangga Community Development Hub (ACDH) initiative, various faculties at Universitas Airlangga (Unair) are working together with tourism communities in Bintan in researching and enhancing technological and cultural literacies.

The ACDH initiative is managed by Unair's Center for Research and Community Services (LPPM). The initiative is aimed to enhance communities' access to research and further implement research results to improve their life condition. The ACDH is partnering with Bintan local government, especially the Pengudang village community. Bintan Island is bordering Indonesia with Malaysia and Singapore. Its unique culture and nature attract tourists from neighboring countries. However, the pandemic hits and left Bintan with its lowest posture in the tourism industry. Pengudang village is famous for its fishing culture and develop community-based tourism. They want to rise stronger in tourism by implementing important technologies, such as marine and cultural products. The ACDH is designing research in Bintan in early 2022 and further recruiting community members in running the survey. The research result is the foundational implementation of technologies in fisheries and cultures. Pengudang community is developing fisheries tools that are produced with the supervision of Universitas Airlangga's faculty of fisheries and marine. Digital technologies are used to promote local Malay culture through the facilitation of the faculty of Humanities. Furthermore, the faculty of medicine and psychology took part in researching mental health and utilizing workshops for Pengudang locals.

The collaboration of faculties and communities in Bintan is the result of an intensive collaboration. Research initiated by faculty members is utilizing its good connection with the community. It is not a one-off relation-ship. An ongoing and sustainable connection is crucial in keeping the trust. A useful research result is what can be beneficial to society. Yet these are important initiatives to intensify community growth in a post-Pandemic era.

BLENDED LEARNING: LEVERAGING TECHNOLOGY FOR 21ST-CENTURY LEARNING

Abhishek Mohan Gupta, Pro-Chancellor and Member of the Governing Body, Jagran Lakecity University, India.

Abstract

The presentation would focus on connecting three key themes. Firstly, blended learning is clearly a reality in this third decade of the 21st century. The post-Covid world has truly become alive to the fact of blended learning. The transition from face-to-face learning to online learning and now to blended learning is a reality we experience across the higher education space. What one needs to keep in mind is that for drawing the maximum leverage from this transformation, it needs to be carefully calibrated and well-planned. Educational institutions and faculty would need to carefully plan `content in context`. What is ideal to be transacted online and what is essentially required to be done online is a conscious decision that needs to be made. When the world moved online during Covid it was by necessity and not by choice and involved shifting to online what was earlier done face-to-face with little time for assessing its utility and effectiveness. Secondly, Blended learning requires us to accept the fact that learning is not merely limited to the four walls of the classroom. Classrooms are not spaces for teaching but zones of learning. Further, learning in the blended mode happens well beyond the classroom too. Finally, as part of blended learning, there is a temptation to believe that technology replaces the formal classroom. It needs to be stressed that technology is an aid to learning and not a replacement for existing modes of learning. What blended learning privileges is technology-mediated learning and not technology-controlled learning. This would become possible when our `credo` of blended learning is `learning first` and `learner always`.



Project and Research-Based Learning on Green Technology to Support the Sustainable Development Goals on Society

ABSTRACT

United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) launched sustainable industrial development through Green Industry in 2011. Green Industry is the development and production of industries that do not harm human health and the environment. The main focus of green industry development is to increase the efficiency of natural resources, reduce pollution and industrial waste, and minimize the risk of using chemicals. Indonesia supports the achievement of sustainable development goals (SDGs) for 2030. In the field of agroindustry, Indonesia still needs to strengthen the development of the green industry. Indonesia, Malaysia, and Thailand are the three largest palm oil-producing countries in the world.

As a consequence, the estimated total of waste biomass produced is around 100 million tons/ha/year. Besides oil palm biomass, Indonesia also produces agricultural wastes, such as rice straw (55 million ton/year), corn biomass (12 million ton/year), soybean biomass (781 thousand ton/year), and cassava (467 ton/year). The agriculture biomass is mainly composed of lignocellulose material, generally consisting of celluloses (45-55%), hemicelluloses (35-40%), and lignins (5-20%). Biomass-acting enzymes are the group of lignocellulolytic enzymes that have a key role to convert biomass into beneficial products, such as animal feed, bioenergy, and organic fertilizer. The main enzymes produced by lignocellulolytic bacteria and fungi are cellulases, hemicellulases, pectinases, and ligninases. Industrial application of those enzymes is increasing year by year due to the eco-friendly impact of the enzymes. Most of the ASEAN countries still import biomass-acting enzymes from other countries. Indonesia is a potential country to produce biomass-acting enzymes due to the mega-biodiversity of natural resources of fungi and bacteria. Universitas Airlangga as a member of the ASEAN University Network has concerned to involve the Sustainable Development Goals topic in the project or research-based learning. Students can improve their skills and knowledge by designing projects or research based on green industry aspects. The student can choose project-based learning or research-based learning starting from the 5th semester. We also offer this program to overseas students, namely AMERICA Program. Enzymology course is the one of AMERTA Programs followed by students from Asian countries, such as the Philippines, Malaysia, Brunei, and Thailand. The courses are held by a research-based learning system consisting of class lecturing and field study. The students are expected to be able to design and do the research on exploring, characterization, purification, and production of the biomass-acting enzyme from natural resources. Proteomic Laboratory of Universitas Airlangga successfully produced biomass-acting enzymes, namely Excelzyme as a consortium lignocellulolytic enzyme, and also conducted the community workshop for Excelzyme application for organic fertilizer, animal feed, and pulp & paper industry.

CREATING AND LEVERAGING SYNERGY BETWEEN INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND TEACHING-LEARNING PROCESSES IN 4IR by

Abstract

The early part of the new millennium heralded the onset of Education 2.0 as it witnessed technology percolating the education process as teachers and students alike began using basic technology. This era is followed by Education 3.0 where intensive infiltration of user-generated internet on a massive scale as well as many and varied technological advancements became its hallmarks. During this period, with increased access to their own information, learners have the option to learn virtually. The availability of several platforms makes it possible for the learners to establish, use, and maintain easy connectivity with members of the faculty and other students also. The erstwhile back-and-forth student-teacher-centric processes are replaced by a unique personalized and networked approach to education where learners' independence, autonomy, and connectivity to different and diverse sources of information became the primary reasons for real celebrations all over. Now, Higher Learning Institutions are on the cusp of an entirely new phase, which is the harbinger of Education 4.0, which is the most desired and desirable approach as it aligns itself with the emerging Fourth Industrial Revolution or 4IR powered by smart technology that has immense potential to impact human lives. Swift developments that took place in the science and technology space subsequent to the onset of 4IR had their concomitant consequences not only on the people's lives but also on those of the learners. They are forcing educators to adopt new teaching methods as curricula underwent radical changes due to the introduction of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and the Internet of Things (IoT), etc. Education 4.0 is a purposefully well-thought-through philosophy toward a teaching-learning approach making it thoroughly in sync with Fourth Industrial Revolution as both are intrinsically intertwined. Keeping creativity-bringing something new into being-as its pivot, Education 4.0 underscores the importance of honing the skills of the learners to face and deal with the new era challenges head-on It is highly personalized, creative, and learner-centric and is poised to supplant the obsolete and clumsy conventional educational procedures that have long outlived their utility while welcoming and giving way to cyber-physical systems that are prevalent across all industries today.

Abstract


